office for tests and when I came back, I was hit in the face with the news."

With fundraisers to pay for the high cost of non-traditional treatments, Karla prepared herself and her daughter, Samiha, for life without someone who had been such a difference maker in their lives. Tragically, Davis Jr., passed away from lung cancer 10 months later.

"If I didn't have my mother for support and daughter to remind me how special Howard was, I don't know what would have happened," Karla said. "We stayed with the MMA business for a while, but it wasn't the same without him."

As she pondered her future, it was something that she was told that stuck in her head. Because of her passion, zest for life and embracing new challenges, real estate was thought to be her calling - and they were right.
